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### SYRAH - VALLEE DE LA BRETONNE 2020

Blackberries, herbs and sweet spices develop on the nose. Full body with creamy tannins and texture. It's well-rounded, dense and balanced with an intense core of creamy dark berries and peppercorns on the mid-palate. Vivid and flavorful finish with length. Drink or hold.

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### MOURVEDRE - LES TRAVERSES 2020

Dark berries, wafers, thyme and warm spices on the nose following through to a full body with plush tannins. Full and dense with a compact core of creamy berries at the center and a flavorful finish. Drink or hold.

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### GRENACHE GRIS - LA LAUZE DU MOULIN 2021

Apples, baked pears, cinnamon and toasted brioche on the nose. Medium body with fresh acidity. Lemons mingle at the center with some herbs and mild spices. Bone dry and succulent. Drink now.
